# PASH

- 23% (of 200) of breast biopsies
- Usually coincident with other pathology
- Can be the dominant pathology
- Hormonal etiology possible
- LOCALIZED STROMAL OVERGROWTH WHICH SIMULATES LOW GRADE ANGIOSARCOMA
- Can grow over time
- Can recur after excision

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## Differential diagnoses

- Endometrioid carcinoma**
  - Lacks multiple architectural patterns & intraluminal secretions
  - Lacks PTC like nuclei
  - Negative GATA-3, TTF-1; ER/ PR positive
- Serous and Clear cell carcinoma**
  - Nuclear & Architectural features different
  - P53 mutant and p16 overexpressed unlike MLCA
  - Usually lack HNF1B and Napsin A (can be expressed)
- Carcinosarcoma: No heterologous elements**
- Other mesenchymal tumors (solid)**

Table 2. Normal and Pathologically Altered Features of Pediatric Liver Disease

Architecture	Physiology: hepatocyte liver cell plates are well defined; Residual: ductal plate malformation, portocaval shunt, periphery of liver
Alters of bile ducts	Resorption: apparent paucity in early stages of chronic cholestasis
Extramedullary hemopoiesis	Portal tracts: granulocyte infiltrates/lymphocytic infiltrates
Thyroid-like nodules	Plasmacytoma, erythropoiesis, and eosinophilia, hemopoiesis
Thyroid-like nodules	Residual: nodules
Chronic disease

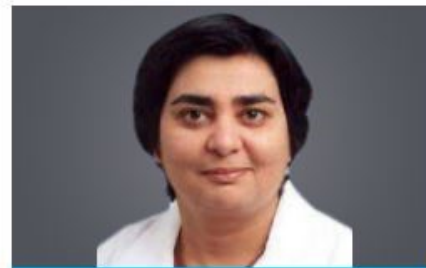
