- · 23% (of 200) of breast biopsies
- · Usually coincident with other pathology
- · Can be the dominant pathology
- · Hormonal etiology possible
- LOCALIZED STROMAL OVERGROWTH WHICH SIMULATES LOW GRADE ANGIOSARCOMA
- · Can grow over time
- · Can recur after excision

LIVE Powered by Zeem

- Lacks multiple architectural patterns & intraluminal secretions
- · Lacks PTC like nuclei

Endometrioid carcinoma

. Negative GATA-3, TTF-1; ER/ PR positive

Serous and Clear cell carcinoma

- · Nuclear & Architectural features different
- P53 mutant and p16 overexpressed unlike MLCA
- . Usually lack HNF1B and Napsin A (can be expressed)

Carcinosarcoma: No heterologous elements Other mesenchymal tumors (solid)







